The Taylor High School PTO would like to invite you to this year's Homecoming Dance! This dance is for Taylor High School students and their dates (7th and 8th graders are not permitted to attend, nor is anyone 21 years or older). Students who are attending from another high school, must be accompanied by a Taylor High School student.

EACH ATTENDEE must return this completed permission slip to purchase a dance ticket. The back must be completed if bringing someone from another school! Tickets must be purchased by the end of the day on Friday (9/9).

ABSOLUTELY NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE DOOR

Tickets will cost \$15.00 each.

The following regulations apply to all who attend:

NO BACKPACKS OR LARGE PURSES ALLOWED

- Those attending must arrive no later than 8:30pm
- All school handbook regulations for behavior apply as well as the policy regarding COVID.
- Dress must be modest, or a student may be refused entrance
- Dancing that is determined immodest by an administrator must stop
- Students from another school <u>must have a permission slip signed by their administrator and parent. If we do not have it they cannot attend!</u>
- Once you leave the dance, you will not be readmitted
- Parents of students who break any rules will be called and students will be sent home
- There will be a Professional Breath Alcohol Tester (Breathalyzer) present at the dance. All attendees are susceptible to being tested. Penalties for having abused alcohol or drugs are: up to and including ten days out-of-school suspension and possible recommendation for expulsion.
- If it has been determined that an attendee has abused alcohol or drugs, law enforcement officers and school administrators will be notified immediately. The attendee's parents will then be notified, and that attendee must be picked up immediately.
- Those attending the dance must remain at Taylor HS until 9:30pm. The Parent/Guardian will be called by a chaperone to grant permission for any attendee to leave the dance prior to 9:30pm.
