1) Welcome and Agenda Review

2) Three Rivers Elementary School Updates - Adam Biedenbach (from his notes)

- a) TBTs
- -data-driven discussions
- -Elizabeth Sillies is helping facilitate monthly data meetings
- -better use of data and team meetings.
- -RTI/MTSS process has improved
- -Three River admin visited Southwest to compare processes and procedures when using MAP data to drive instructional decisions. Finished MAP testing before break so that teachers can utilize the data for the new quarter.
- -Mr. Biedenbach has started using staff meetings as time to work together through issues and have staff discuss their strengths to help others.

b) Intervention Process

- -the intervention process is now helping bridge gaps that were previously seen from COVID -Brooke Conklin is helping to use Google Data Studio to help identify student instructional
- needs. This data is used for identifying interventions.

3) ELA Adoption Update

- -also working on science and ss K-8
- -ELA committees have met several times after school
- -Mr. McDonald asked about the monetary needs for this adoption. Title funds will help with ELA and also ESSER funds may be used.
- -discussed a long-term plan for adoption cost to ensure it is in the budget
