- 5. Science Adoption
- -high school: mainly looking at teacher materials. Also need to upgrade some science resources (incubator and microscopes)
- -middle school: Studies Weekly is being used currently auditing this program to ensure it is the best resource
- 6. CKLA for Grade 5
- 7. Title Tutors 25-26 SY: HIVE/Jacket Times
 - -6 current Title Tutors (3 DSS/3 Three Rivers)
 - -enrichment numbers are increasing
- 8. SB 234 (crisis hotline), HB 8 (parent's bill of rights), SB 29 (tech resources)
 - -SB 234 goes into effect in April (handbook, portal, and ID badges)
- -HB 8 goes into effect next school year (a policy will need to be put into place): parents have to be notified of substantial change through the counseling/admin departments
 - -SB 29 goes into effect next school year data privacy
- 9. Others:
 - -Preschool had a licensing visit this week: Passed
 - -Currently have 66 registered kindergarteners
- -Mr. McDonald brought up that next year's kindergarten students will need to pay tuition if they are out of district, regardless of whether or not they have siblings in TRLSD
 - -Flex Days are going from 3 to 2 for next school year (will go out to staff next week)
 - -Science of Reading 97 people have completed, waiting on 33
 - -All 4 of our RE 2s passed the RESA, and can apply for their 5 year licenses
