1. AI Day - May 8
 - Some of the AI team went to the AI Summit a couple of weeks ago.
 - A toolkit was created to help outline the day for the teachers.
 - Messer Construction is coming to talk about the extent to which AI can be used in all fields.
2. DIBELS EOY data
 - We are in week one of DIBELS data
 - K-1 kids are moving up to the green level
 - Kirstie is seeing a lot of growth in the elementary data
 - Kirstie is working to ensure the conversations with teams are happening together so that everyone is on the same page.
 - 4th grade schedule ensures no one is missing Tier 1 instruction throughout the day. Gifted students receive services during intervention times.
 - Mrs. Stafford asked how support for students going from 4th to 5th grade is going to be implemented. Kirstie said 4th-grade RIMPS are going up to 5th grade next year. Title tutors are also going to change schedules and this will help support 5th-grade intervention. CKLA will be implemented in 5th grade next year as well to align.
3. Math Interventions

- MIMPS (Math Improvement Monitoring Plans) is on the horizon and will be in schools in the near future.
 - Currently looking at an mClass for math: this will help with assessments and monitoring.
 - Kirstie is looking to better structure interventions that are individualized to each student's needs.
 - Kirstie is showing different math strategies with staff in staff meetings to better help them support student learning.
 - Putting an emphasis on student talk to help learn from each other.
4. HS Science Materials
- They are maintaining all materials except for three courses.
 - Currently, all resources are available for parent review.
5. Title Tutors 25-26 SY: HIVE/Jacket Times
- 6 tutors, 1 coordinator
 - Federal funding is unknown right now
 - There will probably be a K-12 PD offered
6. SB 29: Student Data Privacy
- Adopted & Endorsed Resources
 - On August 1st, it will go into effect
 - Clever will need to be cleaned up - teachers will no longer be able to automatically load resources in; they will have to go through a process to ensure staff and students are protected.
 - All resources will have to be "adopted and endorsed."
