- 1. High School Scheduling & Course Guide (Mark Smiley & Katie Ryan)
- -Katie shared the Academic Pathways (Honors/Advanced, CCP, UC Early IT, Education, Business, Career Academies, Great Oaks)
- -Reviewed the Scheduling Timeline for Taylor HS: Begins end of January and goes through early March
- -Scheduling Process goes from November through end of the school year: the process involves all stakeholders including the counselors, teachers, gifted and sped staff, students, and parents. This ensures students are taking courses that are best suited to their academic levels and skillsets.
- -Katie and other counselors audit courses based on numbers and teacher placement
- -Current Enrollment: 682 (THS)
- -CCP: 161 students participating in the program for the 24-25 school year.
- -92 students taking CCP and AP courses
- -Current College/Career Initiatives: Schoollinks, Job Shadowing/Experienships, YouScience, Senior Meetings, Senior College Application Bootcamp, Jr. Meetings, 9-12 Classroom Presentations, Career speakers, field trips, military recruitment, job & career fair, advisory curriculum, college visits, college field trips, college rep visits
- -Future initiatives: SchoolLinks, Linked Up Connect (new program through HCC)

2. Instructional Rounds (Kirstie Saunders)

-Kirstie shared the Instructional Round Tracking document. Focuses are on CKLA, Math, mClass and follows engagement, delivery, growth, differentiation, etc. Each teacher gets a visit 3 times. 64 rounds have been completed. Staff has been accepting of the instructional rounds. -Vertical discussions to align an understanding of all grade levels: where students came from, where are they going academically

3. Al Policy: Potential New Policy
