- B. Legislative Mr. Oser The Ohio House voted 58-37 this week in approving House Bill (HB) 49, the biennial budget. The bill is now in the Senate for consideration. The committee passed HB124. The committee heard proponent testimony on HB58 and SB36. The committee heard sponsor testimony on SB123.
