- -For compliance, we will update this in FinalForms so that all families receive it and have to provide consent or opt out.
- -HB 8 is on the Student Services portion of the website.
- -Megan created a Google Form to document when a student requests a change to their name.
- 2. SPED K-12 Handbook/Preschool SPED Handbooks (Matt)
- -Matt presented both handbooks to the committee (both updated August 2025)
- -We are fully prepared for a desk review, should one be scheduled.
- -Class Dojo was rolled out in the high school to help with parent-teacher communication.
- -Emergency service phone is being used on field trips for quick/easy communication to parents should an emergency situation arise.
