Joe Lind- Plant Manager Fort Miami Power Plant - Update
 Both generators were briefly shut down over the summer; they also operated with
 a skeleton crew over the summer. However, they just signed a new contract with
 a coal contract and feel confident they are back on track.

New Richmond has also experienced a power plant loss. They had an operating levy in November 2020 of 9.4 mils. In June of 2021, Vistra informed the district they were shutting down. This was a 3.75 million dollar loss. They offered a word of caution that the newly assessed property value may cause debate. When the value decreases by greater than 10%, ORC allows for an annual stipend to provide relief for losses. For New Richmond, this meant 1.5 million dollars paid annually. We are pleased that Vistra and the power plant donated \$6000 to the Career Academy.

 We have reached out to our Sports Medicine providers and local vendors for
 support.

3. October Financial Recap - Teri Riesenberg
