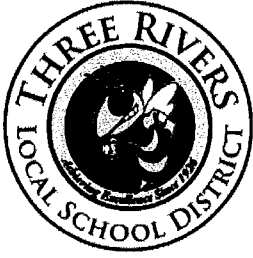

OLD BUSINESS – Dedication of the Nicholas Cordray Memorial Garden took place on September 24 and was a wonderful event; support for the dedication is greatly appreciated. committee

NEW BUSINESS – The State Report Card has been released and although we are more than just testing scores, we need to congratulate our students, staff and parents on the team efforts to achieve these results. The district earned 4 Stars for Achievement, Progress 5 Stars, Closing the Gap 5 Stars, Graduation Rate 5 Stars, and Early Literacy 3 stars for a total of 22 out of a possible 25 stars. This places us in the top 10% of districts in the State of Ohio. Within the Southwest Region of Ohio, we rank #9, and in the top 20 of similar districts in demographics and size in Ohio. This is very encouraging as we progress from the period of COVID and we look to continue improving and sustaining these results. Mr. McDonald states he reviewed and researched 32 districts in Hamilton and Butler and we are one of only 2 of the 32 districts that achieved better than they scored in the pre COVID tests of 2018-2019 for proficiency. He also thanked all staff for coming back into the building post COVID and showing up for our students, exceeding expectations.
