Early Childhood/School-Age Children

Preventive services focused on social and emotional development

5 Star Step Up to Quality Preschool - a safe, and nurturing environment designed to prepare children ages 3-5 to enter kindergarten ready to learn. 7:00 am - 5:30 pm, vouchers accepted.

Promoting Resilient Children - training and consultation for early childhood centers that promote social and emotional development for the children enrolled.

Every Child Succeeds - a free home visitation service for at-risk, first- time mothers to ensure an optimal start in life for their children

SPARK: Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids

- a family focused literacy program that supports the social, emotional and cognitive development of preschool children ages 3-6. FREE for qualifying families.

Camp-I-Can - a 10-week summer camp with swimming, sports and recreational play combined with health and wellness, music and art. Focused on enhancing creativity, leadership and social skills. Last years campers read over 300 books. 7:00 am - 5:30 pm, vouchers accepted.

After-School Enrichment - a community based program that offers a fun and educational experience for children ages 5-12 from the end of the academic school day until 6 pm.



Education

Dedicated to helping children overcome behavioral and learning challenges for smooth transition to adulthood

The Children's Home K-12 School

A therapeutic school designed for students with behavioral and learning challenges. Grades 7-12 includes classroom instruction and labs focused on job readiness and transitioning to adulthood.

Virtual Credit Recovery and Part/Time Virtual Credit Recovery - a program for students who are credit deficient due to academic and behavioral challenges. Designed to provide credits towards graduation for students in grades 9-12. Session times: 7:40 am - 10:40 am, 11:00 am - 2:00 pm, or 2:15 pm - 5:15 pm.

Autism Services

High School - for students diagnosed with autism spectrum and related disorders, grades 9-12.

Ready Set Work! - a 5-week summer program focused on job readiness for students with autism and related disorders, ages 14-21.

Ready 2 Work! - a summer internship program for students with autism and related disorders, ages 18-25.

Olympus Center

Comprehensive psycho-educational evaluations for children and young adults with learning challenges.



Behavioral Health Treatment

Providing the mental health supports and tools children need to succeed

Counseling

School Based - behavioral health treatment provided in school settings, grades K-12.

Early Childhood - specialized treatment for young children ages 2-8 experiencing social, emotional, and behavioral challenges.

Counseling for Caregivers - office-based evaluation and counseling for parents or caregivers of children connected to agency services.

STAR: Integrated Specialized Treatment for Adolescent Recovery - community-based program for teens with co-occurring mental health and substance use challenges.

Community Support Service - community based therapeutic support and case management

Day Treatment

Partial Hospitalization - a campus based therapeutic day treatment program for children that display emotional or behavioral difficulties in home, school or community. Children ages 8-18.

Partial Hospitalization Educational component - an educational program for students grades K-12 who are enrolled in the partial hospitalization program.

Early Childhood Day Treatment - campus based therapeutic day treatment program for children ages 3-8 that display emotional or behavioral challenges.

Medical Management Services

Evaluation, medication, and ongoing follow up to stabilize mental health and behavioral symptoms.

HealthCare Integration - Integrating services such as nutrition, primary care and physical activity with behavioral health and therapeutic education. This approach produces the best outcomes and is the most effective in caring for families and all their healthcare needs.
